Financial Review: \$ 7,606.08

Fundraiser Summary: Jana handed statistics from the sales of the fundraiser. We raised \$ 16042.00 and the total profit was \$ 8170.00. Raised about \$ 4000.00 more than last cookie dough sale. But prices were raised about \$ 1.00. Still a successful fundraiser.

Spring Fundraiser: Jana suggested a pizza fundraiser through Doug. Our cost is \$5.75 profit of \$5.25 with the sale of the pizza being \$11.00. Pizza does not have to be sold by cases. They have a new order form.
